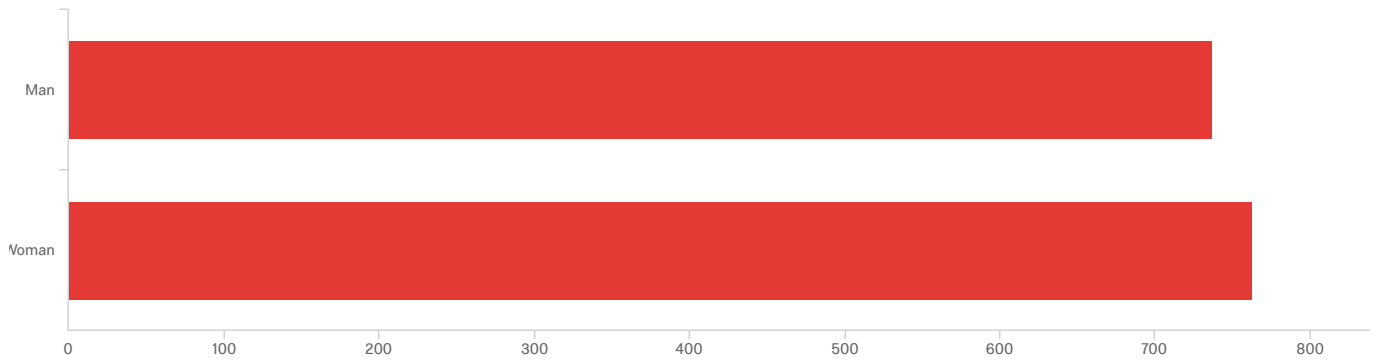

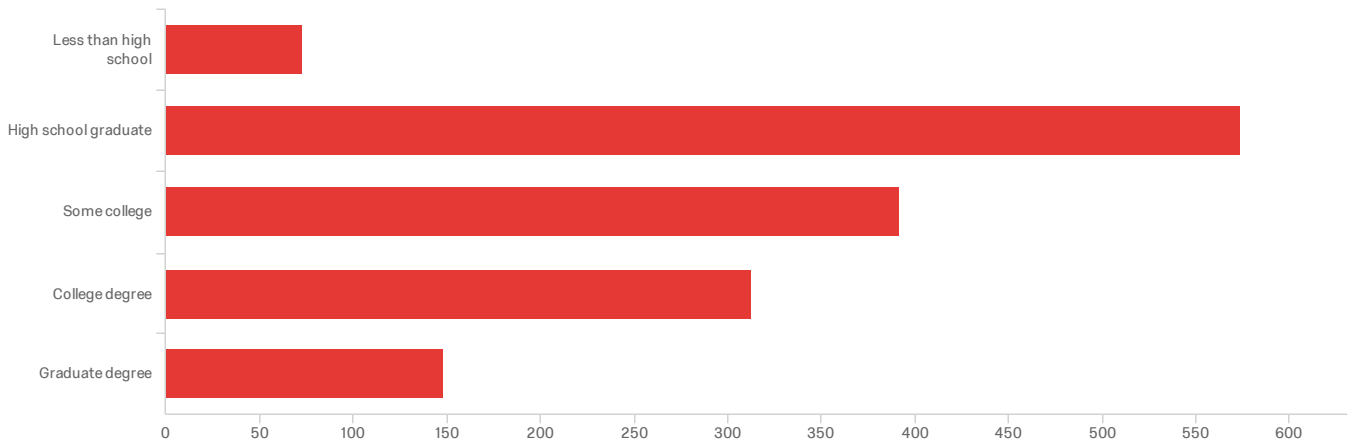

### Q3 - When was your state first included in the United States?



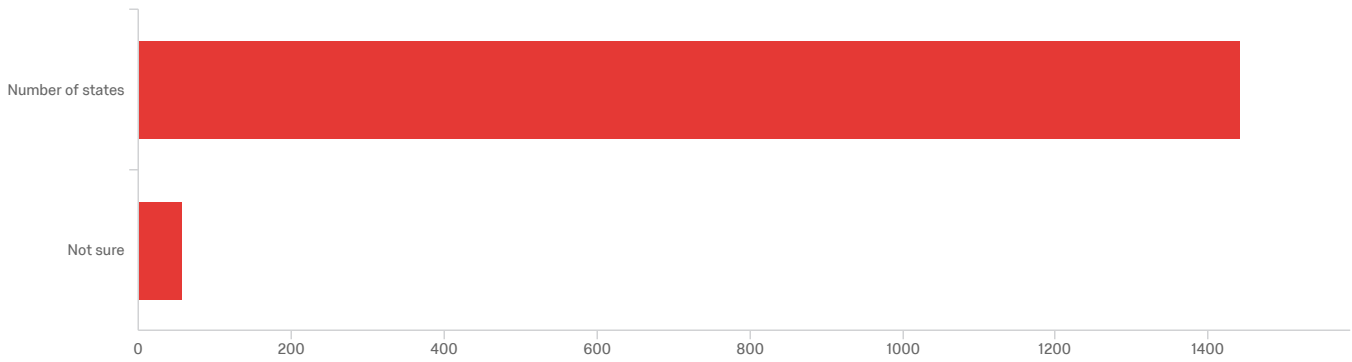

## Q4 - How many states are in the U.S.?



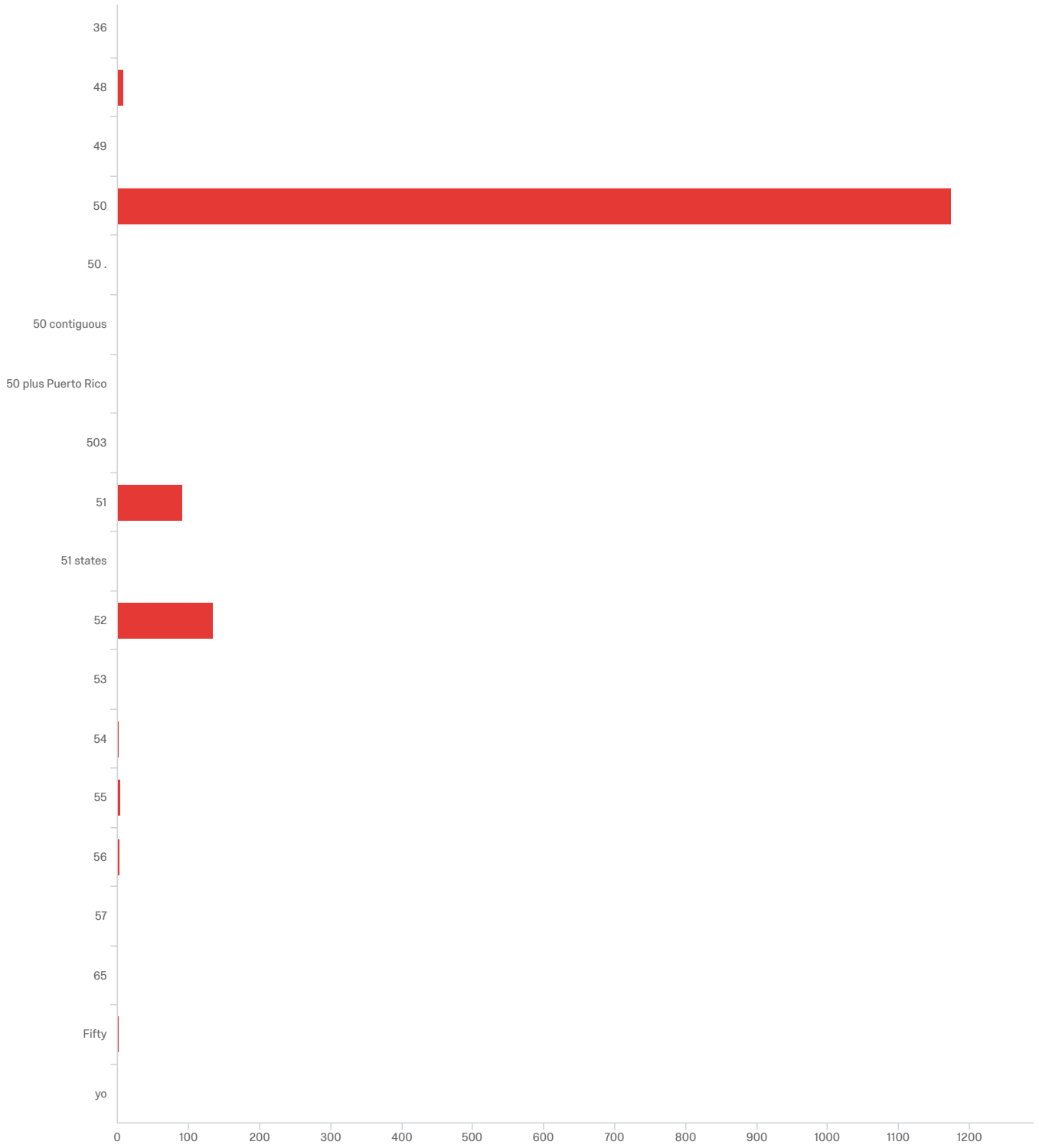

voters elect other officials in your state?

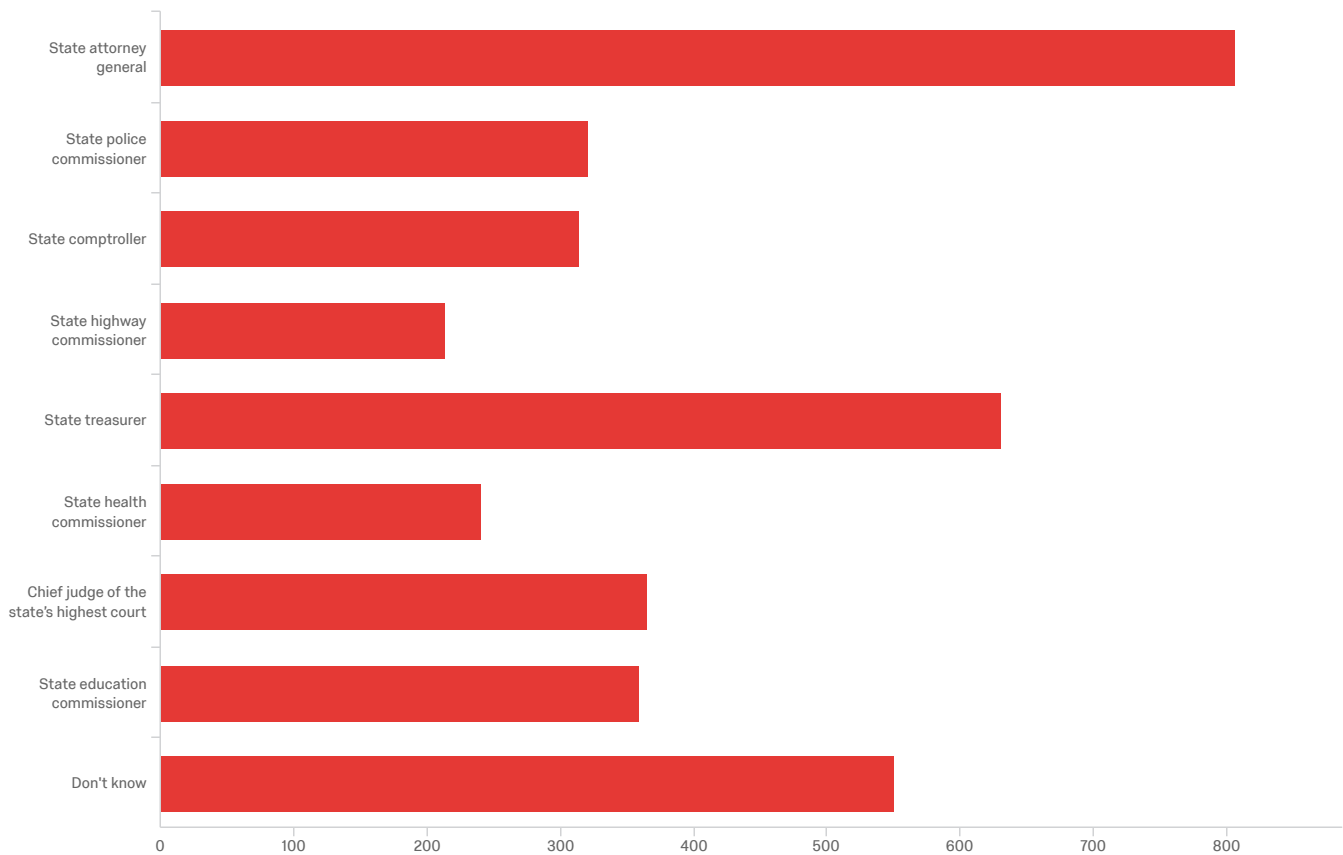

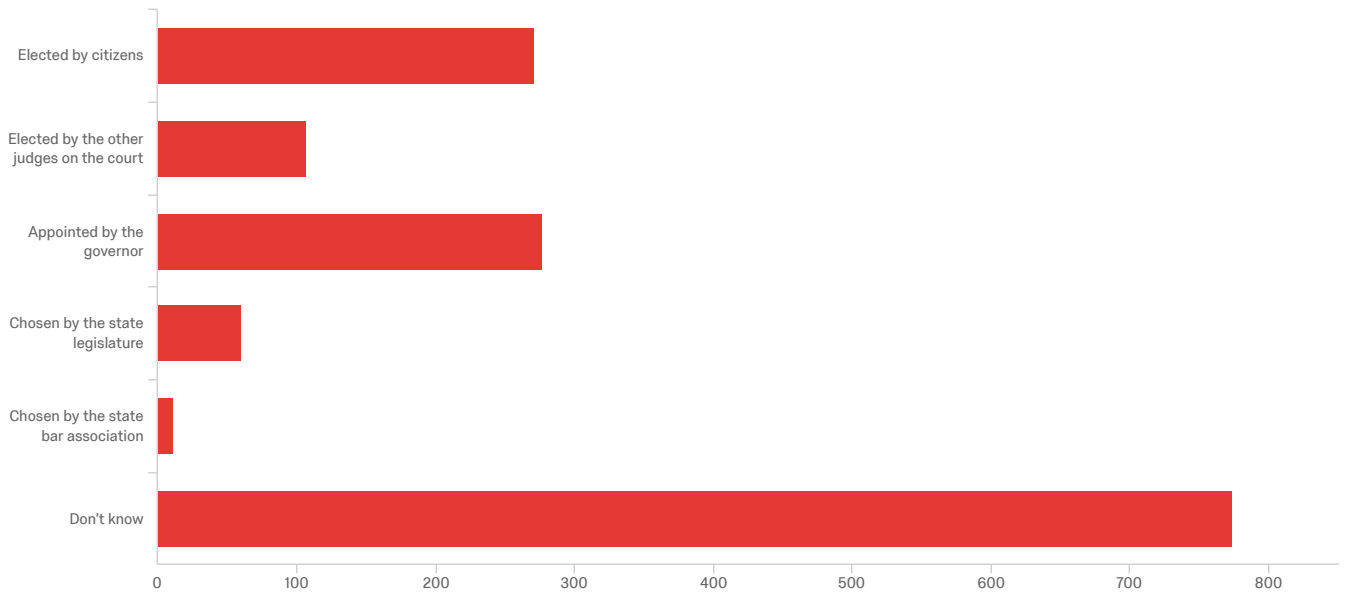

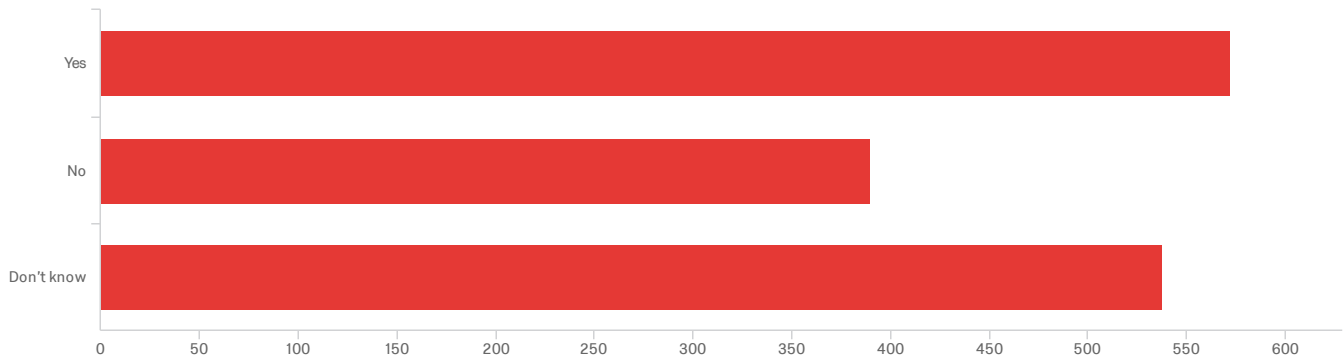

## Q13 - Does your state have its own constitution?

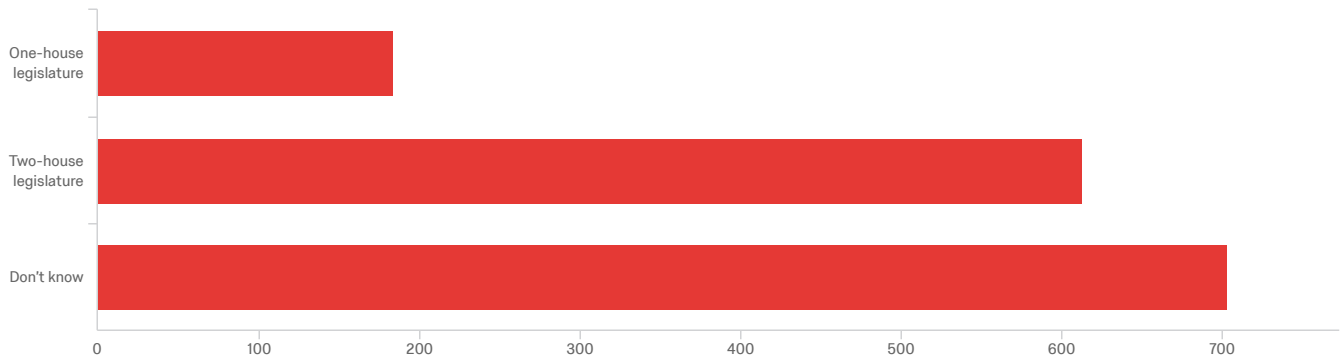

## Q14 - Does your state have a one-house or two-house legislature?

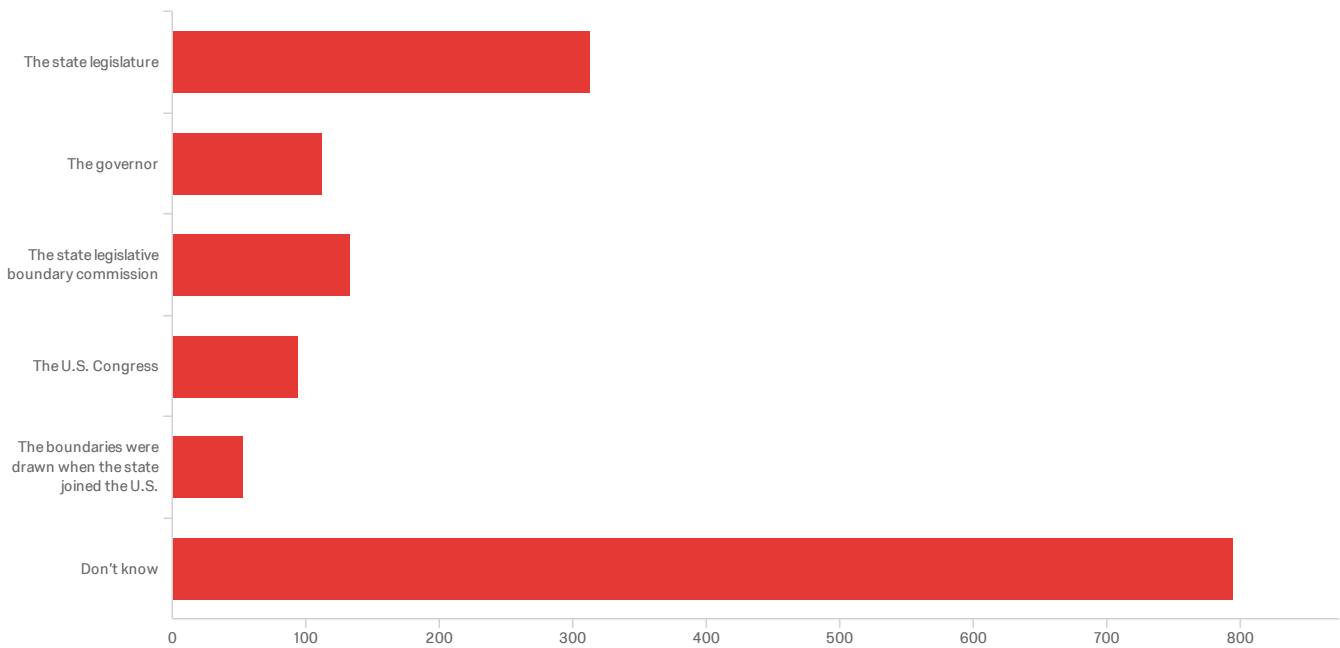

## Q15 - In your state, who draws the boundaries of the legislative districts?



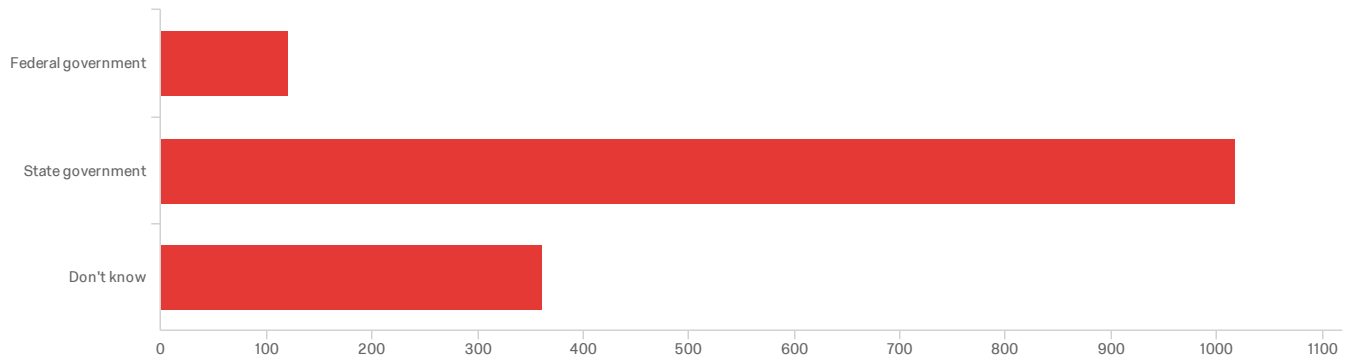

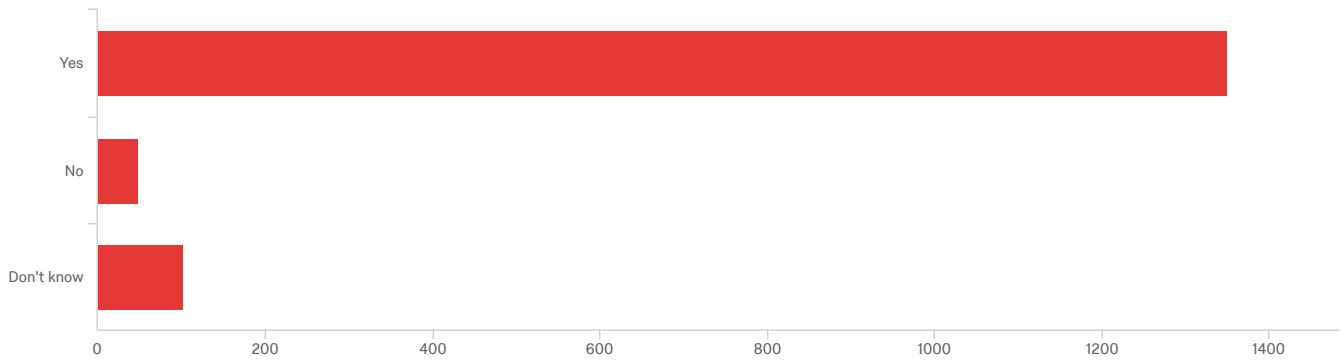

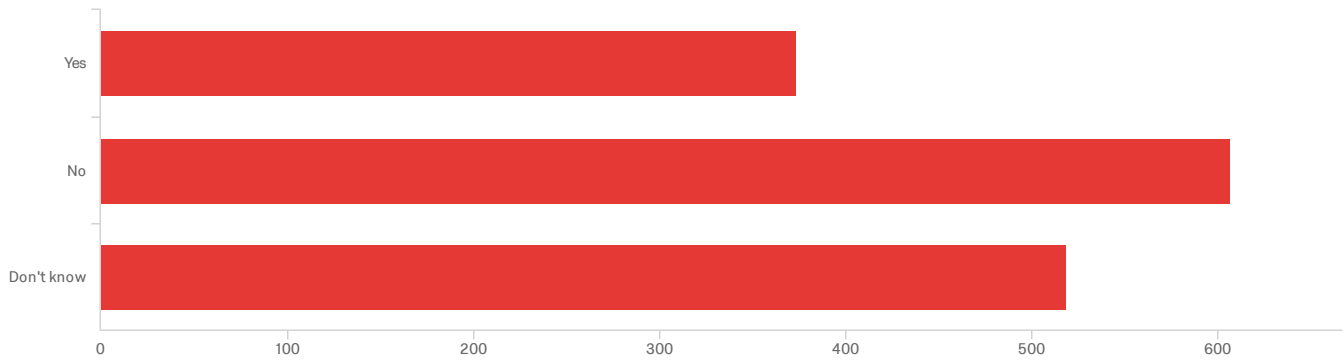

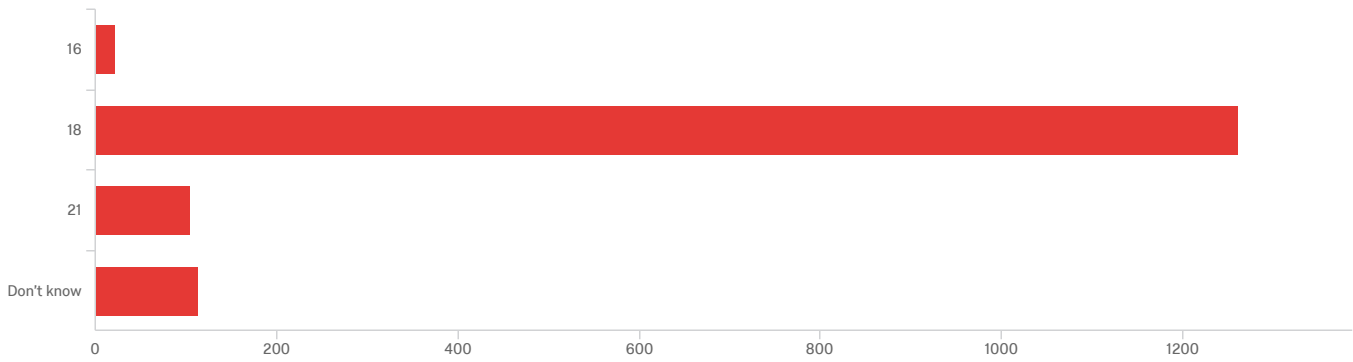

## Q19 - What is the voting age in your state elections?



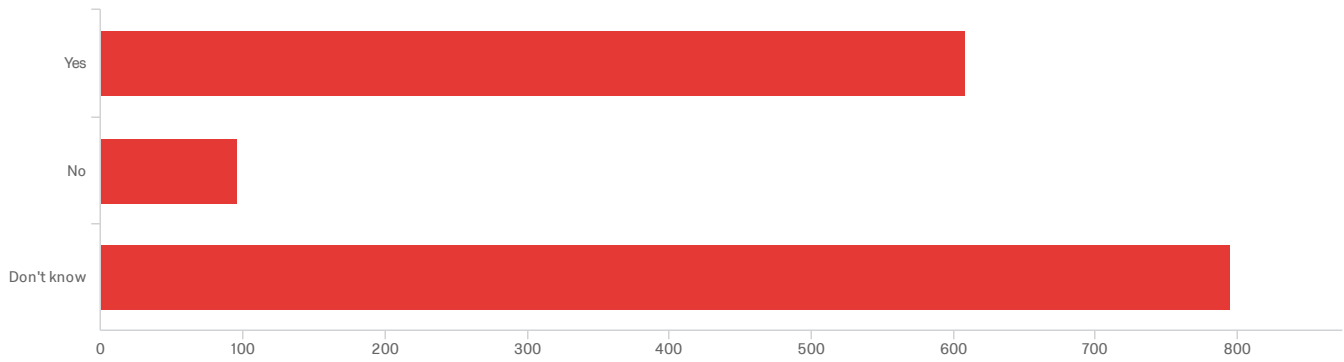

## Q21 - Does your state allow ballot initiatives?



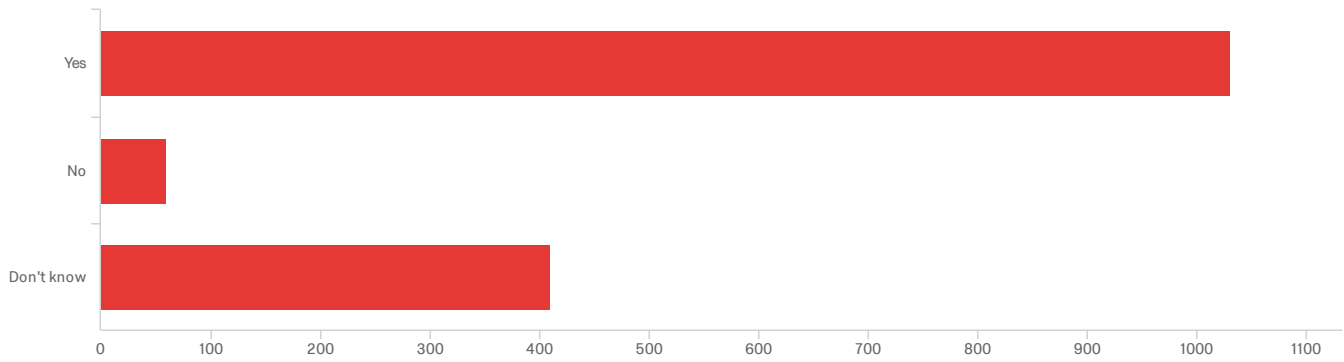

## Q20 - In your state, is voting absentee an option?

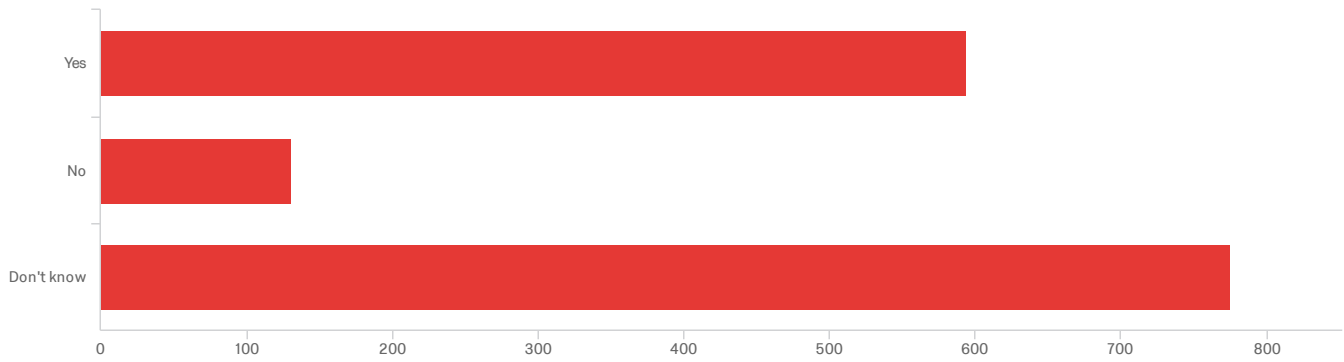

## Q55 - Does your state ever hold special elections for state legislators?

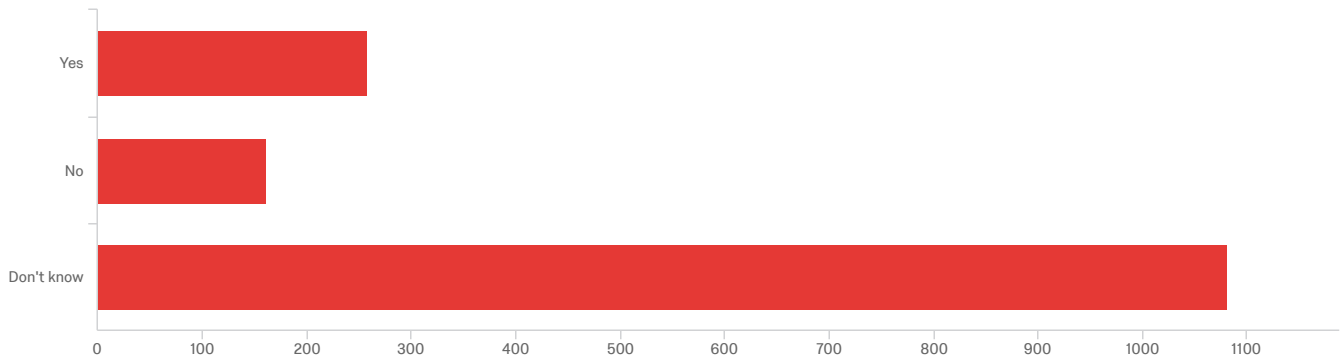

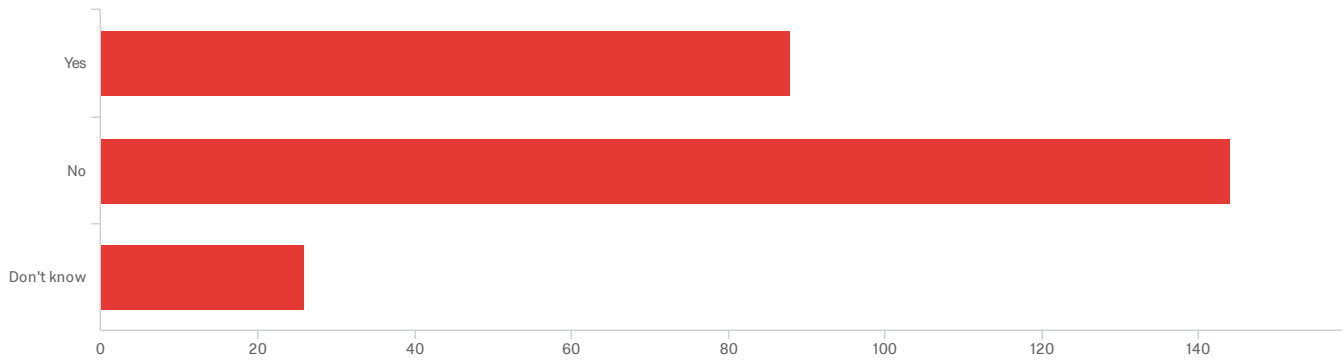

## Q56 - Have you ever voted in an election for members of a special purpose district board?

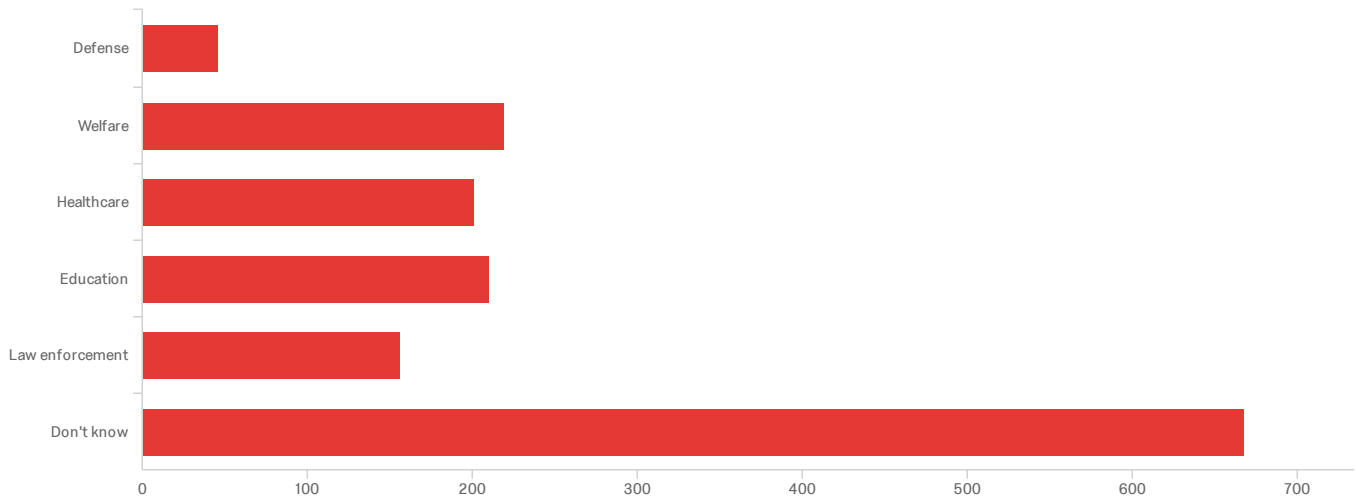

## Q22 - What does your state spend the most money on?



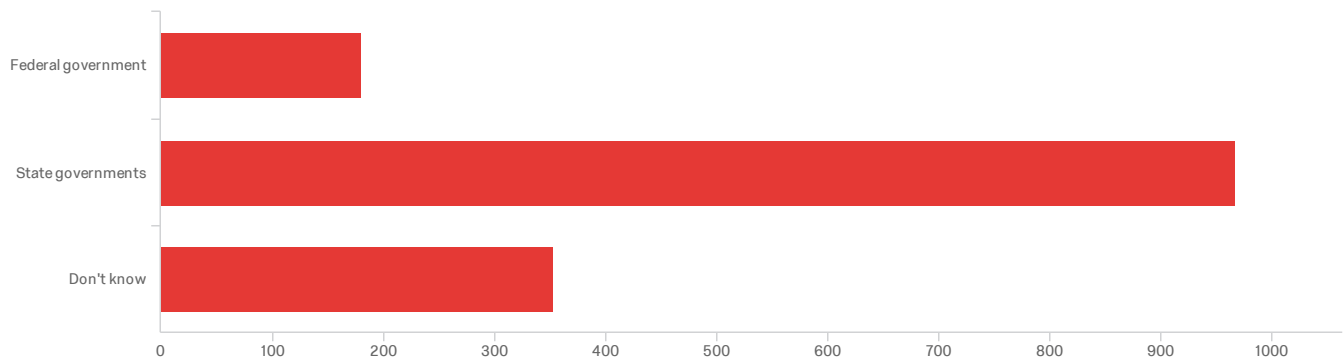

## Q23 - Who is mostly in charge of law enforcement?

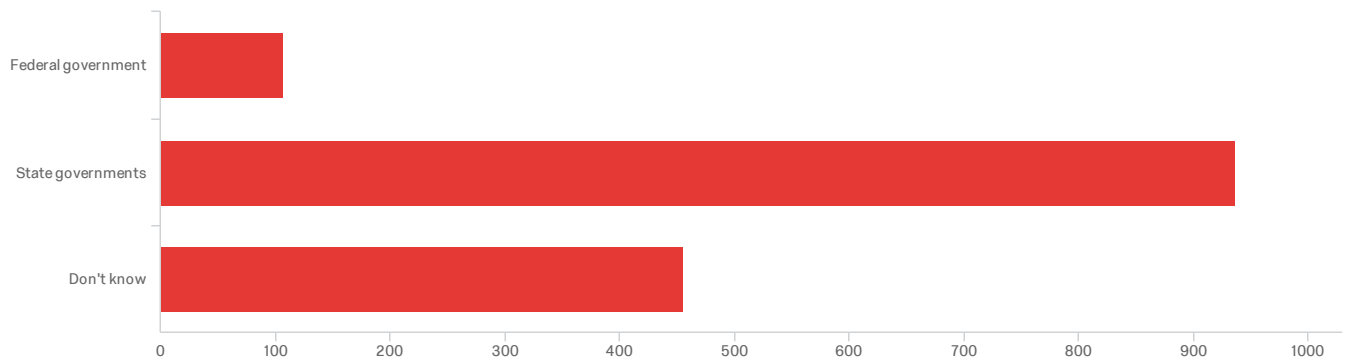

## Q24 - Who makes zoning laws?

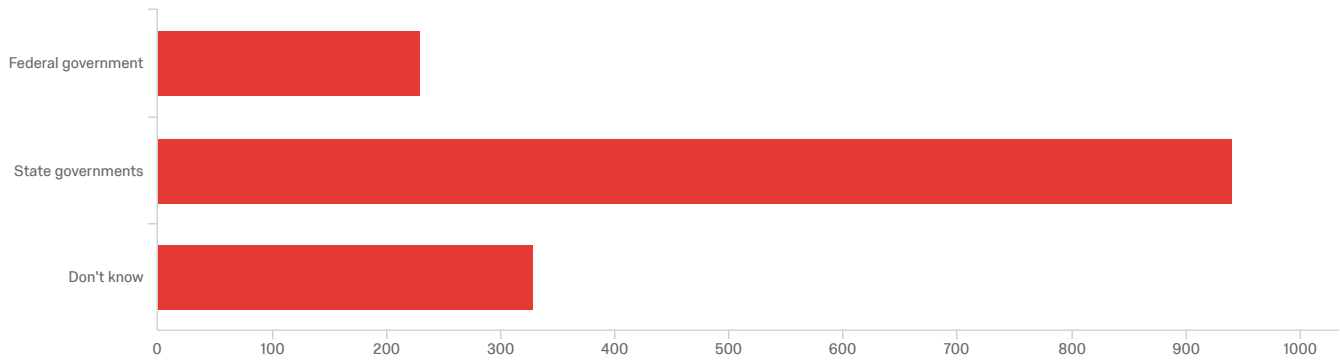

## Q25 - Who is mostly in charge of education?



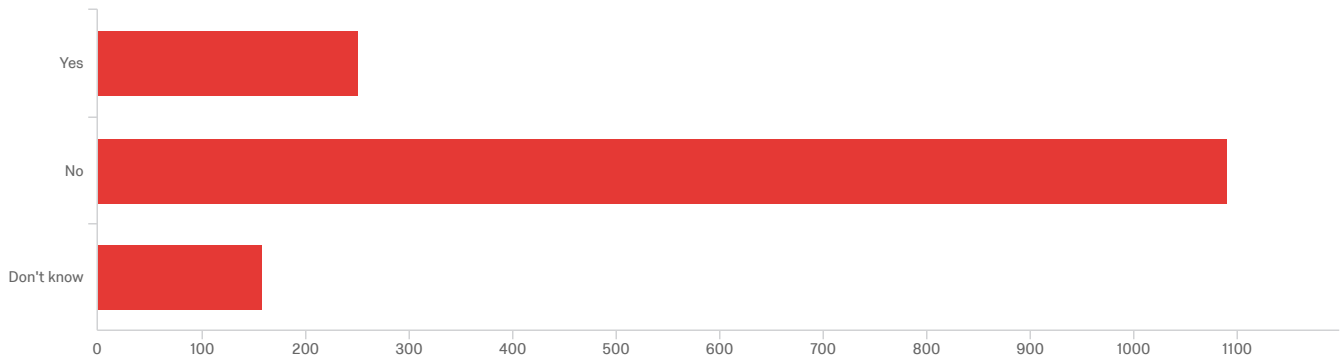

## Q26 - Have you ever contacted one of the members of your state legislature?

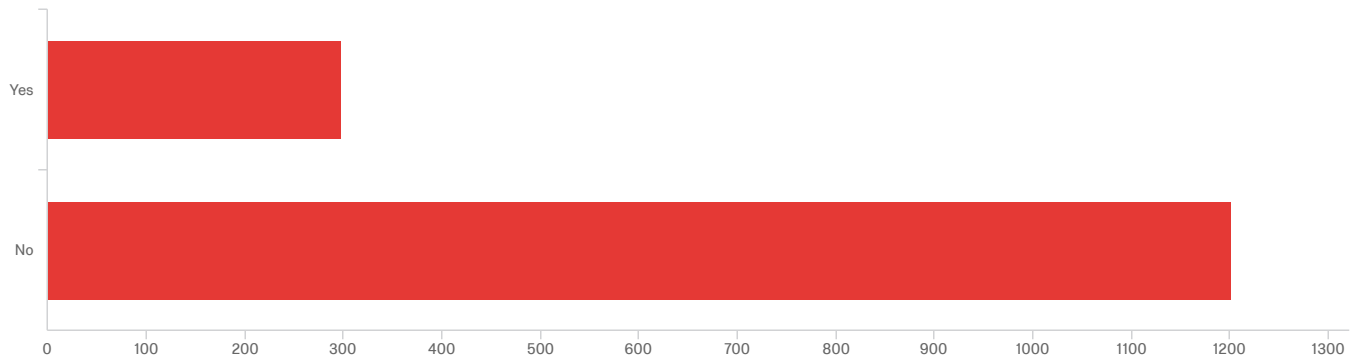

## Q27 - Do you know what was the most debated issue in your state legislature this year?



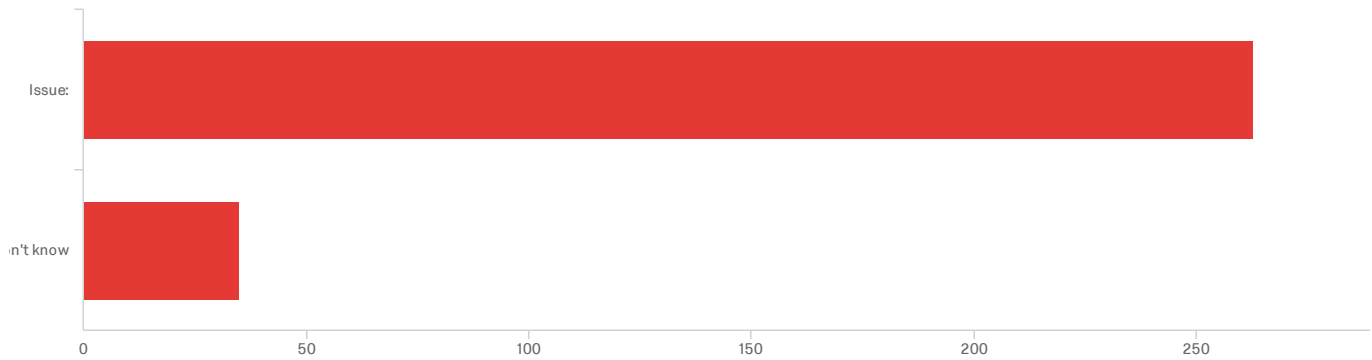

Q33 - Overall, does the federal government or your state government do a better job serving its citizens?



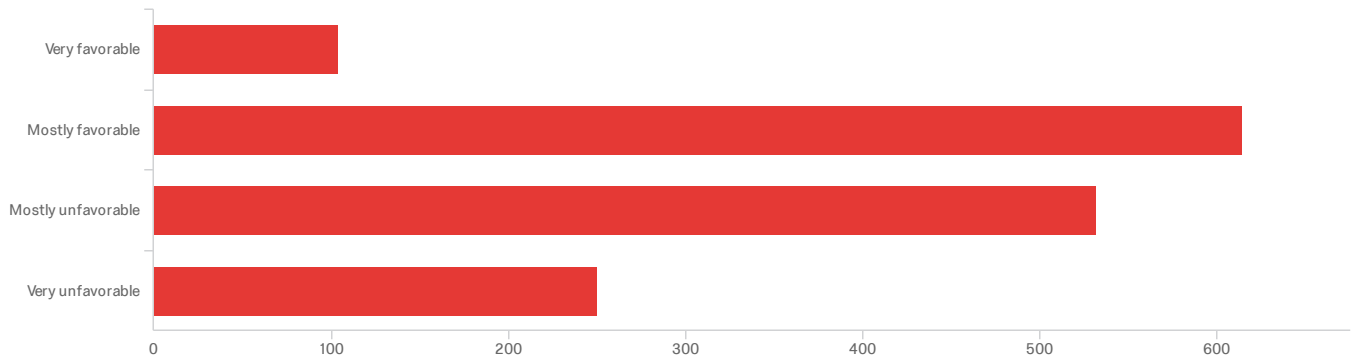

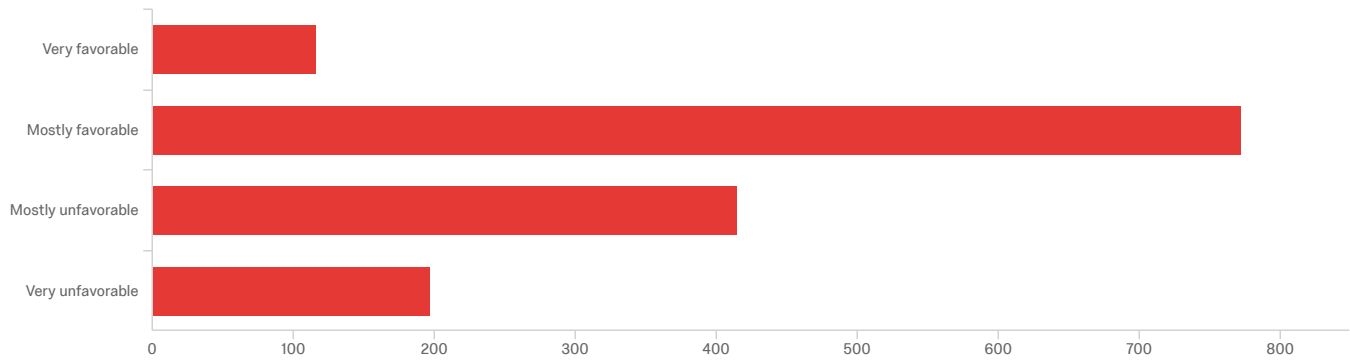

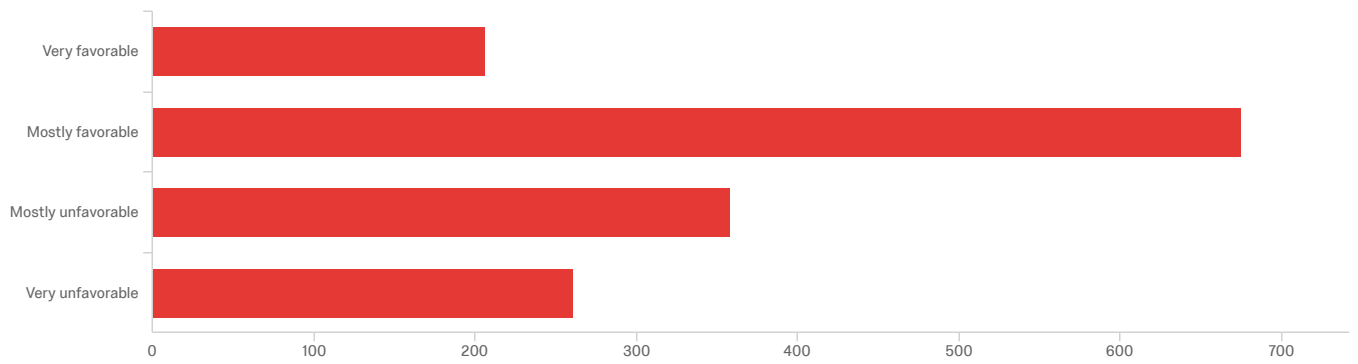

## Q36 - What is your overall opinion of your governor?



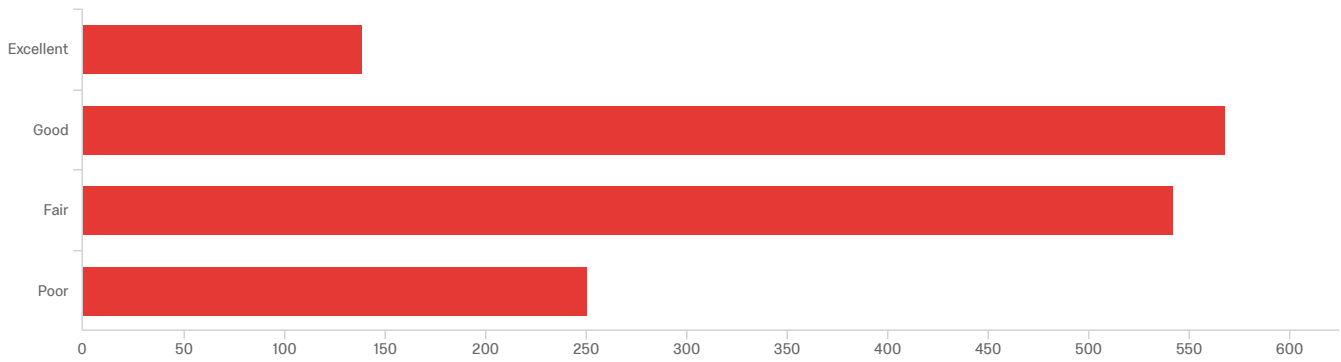

## Q37 - How would you describe the overall economy of your state?



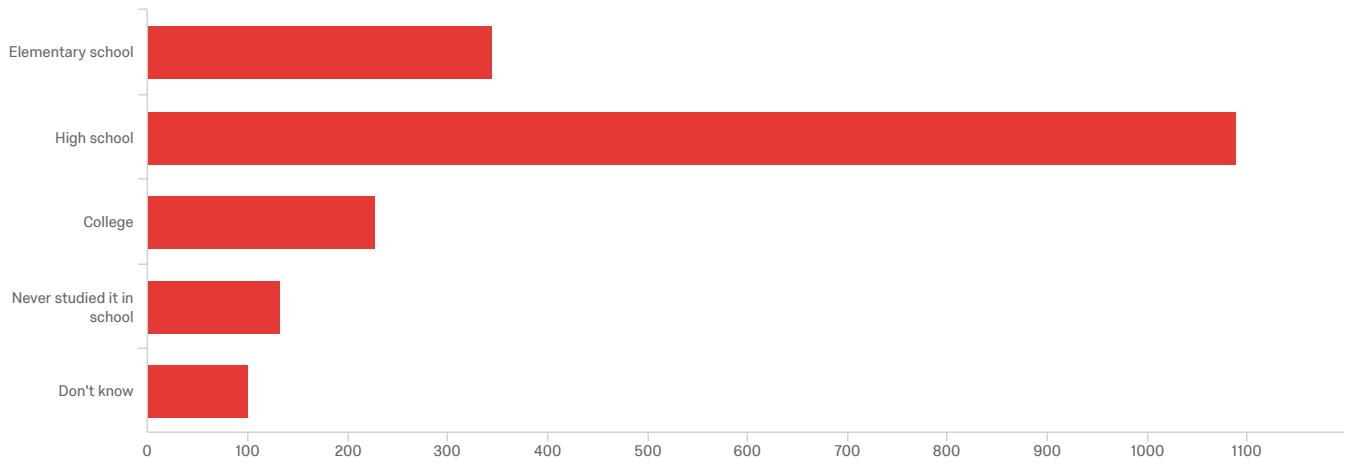

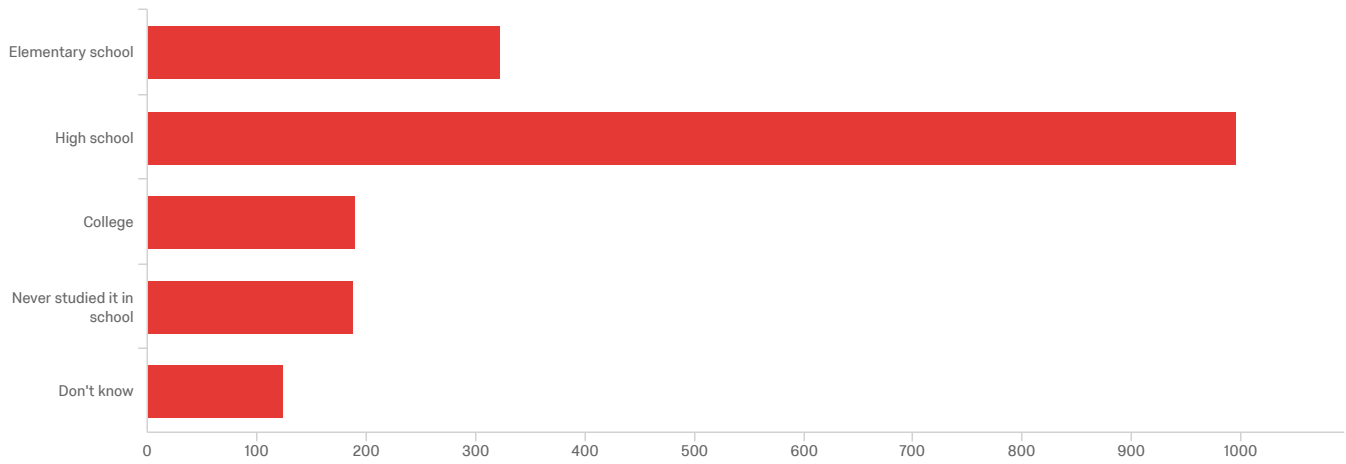

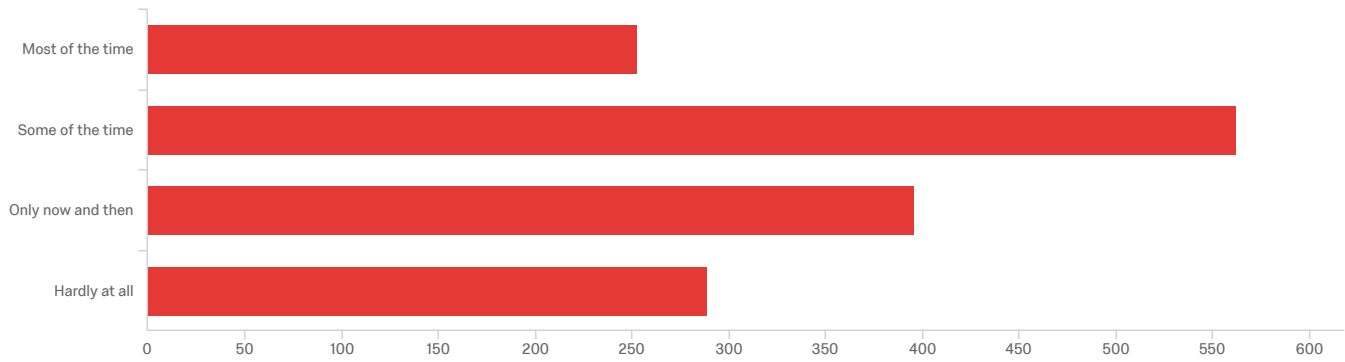

## Q40 - Do you follow what's going on in government and public affairs?



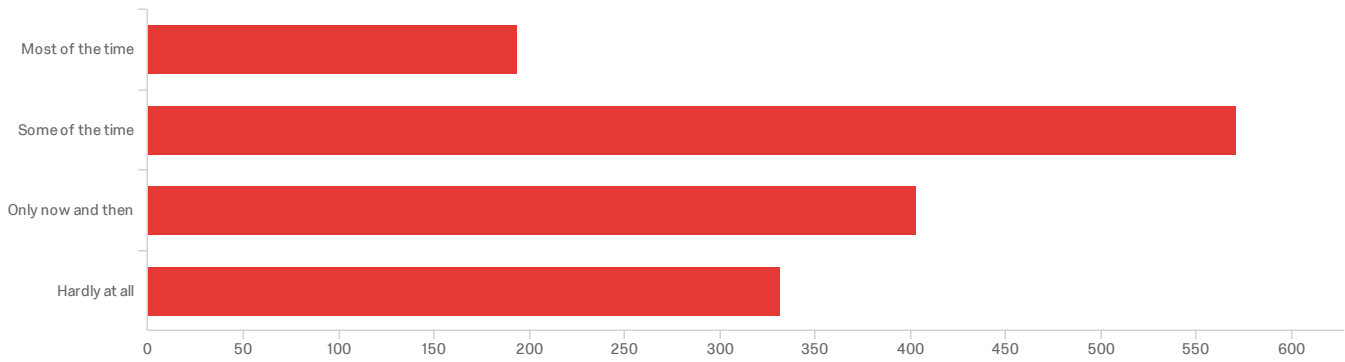

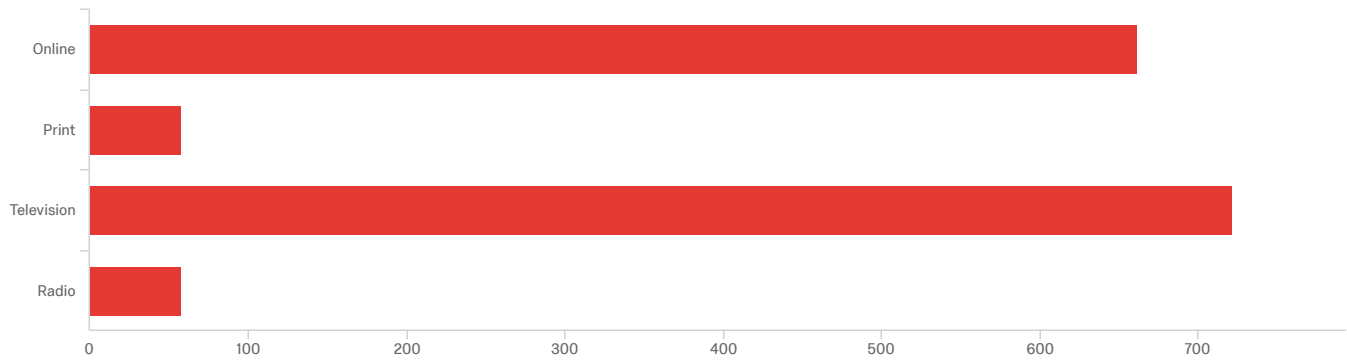

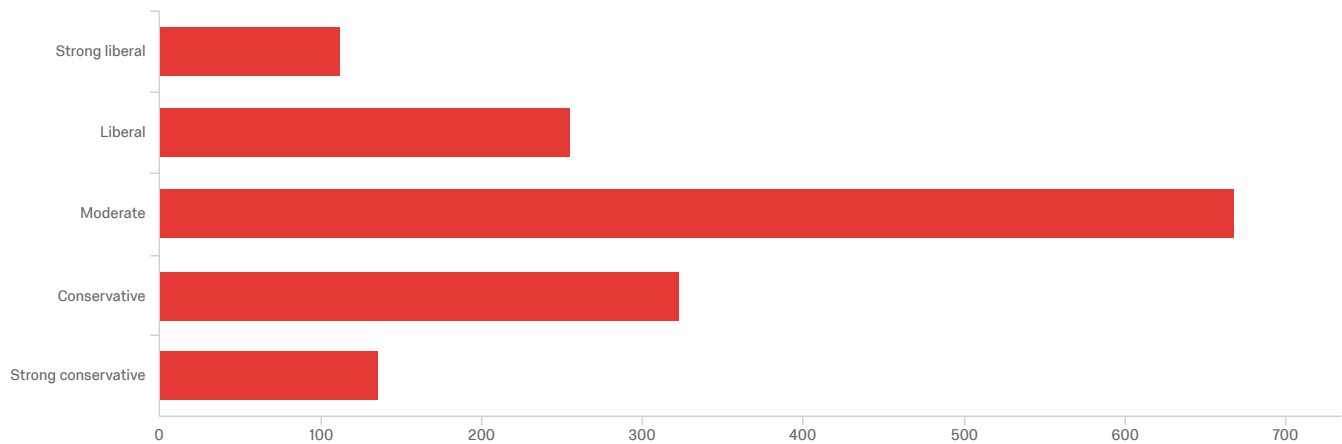
