**NOTIFICATION OF FAILURE TO FILE AN
INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE REPORT OR A POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE
STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION FOR THE 2018 ELECTION CYCLE REPORTS**

Our office is aware that you have failed to file an Independent Expenditure Report or a Political Action Committee Statement of Organization, file appropriate reports, and report expenditures made for the benefit of Kansas candidate(s), as required by law. The required documentation **must be completed and filed within five (5) days** from the date of this notice.

As provided by the Kansas Campaign Finance Act, you have until January 15, 2020, which is 15 days from the date of this notice, to comply with the reporting requirements before civil penalties are imposed. For each unfiled document, a \$10 per day civil penalty is assessed. No civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300) per document. Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required reports within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required reports have been filed.

File the required report within five (5) days with the Secretary of State. As

provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's office.
