Selected E-Cigarette Results

YRBS is reflective of a randomized sample of Kansas 9th-12th grade public school students. Survey was conducted in Spring 2019 school semester.

E-Cigarette Use:

<u>Survey Item</u>	<u>2017</u>	<u>2019</u>	<u>Increase</u>
Have you ever used an electronic vapor product (EVP)?	34.8%	48.6%	39.7%
Students who used an EVP on at least 1 day of the last 30:	10.6%	22%	107%
Students who used an EVP daily for the last 30 days:	1.4%	5.2%	271%

Cigarettes vs. E-Cigarettes Comparison (2019):

<u>Survey Item</u>	<u>Cigarette</u>	<u>E-Cigarette</u>	<u>% Higher</u>
Have you ever used?	24.8%	48.6%	196%
Students who used on at least 1 day of the last 30:	5.8%	22%	379%
Students who used daily for the last 30 days:	1.3%	5.2%	400%

E-Cigarette Use: Comparison of Males & Females

<u>Survey Item</u>	<u>Males</u>	<u>Females</u>
Have you ever used an electronic vapor product (EVP)?	46.2%	51%
Students who used an EVP on at least 1 day of the last 30:	21.3%	22.8%
Students who used an EVP daily for the last 30 days:	6.6%	3.6%
