

Legislative COVID-19 Vaccinations

Legislators and their Statehouse staff will be eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine beginning in February. There will be a vaccine clinic set up in the Nickell Armory Gym, located at 2722 SW Topeka Boulevard, on February 2, 3 and 4 where Legislators and Statehouse staff can receive the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Vaccine will be administered by appointment only.

Individuals currently under isolation for a positive COVID-19 case or under quarantine for an exposure to COVID-19 should not break isolation or quarantine to receive the vaccine; you may receive the vaccine once you have been released. The CDC recommends that anyone who has received monoclonal antibodies or convalescent plasma to treat COVID-19 wait 90 days before receiving the vaccine. If you have tested positive in the last 90 days for COVID-19, you are still encouraged to take the vaccine if you are recovered from being ill.

If you are unable to receive the vaccine during this vaccination clinic, an alternate date will be set up in the near future to include those unable to make this round.

Legislators and staff will receive an email from KDHE staff with further directions to set an appointment in the next few days.
