Resolution No. 20-704

WHEREAS, Section 4 of House Bill No. 2016 of the 2020 special session of the legislature allowed expenditures to be made by state agencies from federal grants received by them; and

WHEREAS, said appropriation provided that no moneys shall be disbursed or expended from the above fund without the approval of the Governor and a majority of the legislative members of the State Finance Council, which was characterized as a matter of legislative delegation and subject to the guidelines prescribed in K.S.A. 75-3711c(c); and

WHEREAS, federal relief funding for the COVID-19 virus has been received by state agencies. Request is made to the State Finance Council to approve expenditures of such funds as listed in the attached document, and any additional coronavirus relief grants that will flow through existing agency federal funds. State agencies will report all such receipts and expenditures to the SPARK taskforce which will then report same to the State Finance Council members on a monthly basis; and

WHEREAS, the requested action is the result of an unforeseeable occurrence, and delay until the next legislative session would be contrary to the best interest of the State; and

WHEREAS, the requested action was not rejected by the 2020 Legislature and is not contrary to known legislative policy; and

WHEREAS, the requested action will assist the Governor's Department in attaining an objective or goal which bears a valid relationship to the powers and duties of the state agency.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the State Finance Council, by the Governor and a majority vote of its legislative members thereof, makes the above findings and approves the expenditure of the amounts in the attached by the state agencies listed therein, effective immediately, plus any additional coronavirus relief grants that will flow through existing agency federal funds.
