C. **Complainant alleges:**

Count 1—Failure to Register as a Lobbyist

On or before February 1, 2017, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then fail to register with the secretary of state by completing and signing a registration form prescribed and provided by the governmental ethics commission in any calendar year before engaging in lobbying, in violation of K.S.A. 46-265 and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 2—Failure to Register as a Lobbyist

On or before March 1, 2018, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then fail to register with the secretary of state by completing and signing a registration form prescribed and provided by the

governmental ethics commission in any calendar year before engaging in lobbying, in violation of K.S.A. 46-265 and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 3—Failure to Register as a Lobbyist

On or before February 11, 2019, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then fail to register with the secretary of state by completing and signing a registration form prescribed and provided by the governmental ethics commission in any calendar year before engaging in lobbying, in violation of K.S.A. 46-265 and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 4—Failure to Register as a Lobbyist

On or before January 7, 2020, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then fail to register with the secretary of state by completing and signing a registration form prescribed and provided by the governmental ethics commission in any calendar year before engaging in lobbying, in violation of K.S.A. 46-265 and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 5—Failure to Register as a Lobbyist

On or before January 10, 2021, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then fail to register with the secretary of state by completing and signing a registration form prescribed and provided by the governmental ethics commission in any calendar year before engaging in lobbying, in violation of K.S.A. 46-265 and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 6—Failure to Register as a Lobbyist

On or before January 10, 2022, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then fail to register with the secretary of state by completing and signing a registration form prescribed and provided by the governmental ethics commission in any calendar year before engaging in lobbying, in violation of K.S.A. 46-265 and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 7—Failure to File Report of Employment and Expenditures

Count 34—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about August 13, 2017, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted representatives for Clean Services Foundation to sponsor the Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation Prevention Act for Kansas*, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 35—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about March 1, 2018, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted representatives for Clean Services Foundation to sponsor or co-sponsor the Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation Prevention Act for Kansas*, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 36—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about July 22, 2018, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted representatives on behalf of Clean Services Foundation, or Special Forces*

of Liberty to sponsor or co-sponsor the Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation Prevention Act for Kansas and the related resolution by Rep. Garber, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 37—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about August 25, 2018, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted a representative on behalf of Clean Services Foundation or Special Forces of Liberty to co-sponsor the Anti-Social Media Censorship Act, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.*

Count 38—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about October 20, 2018, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted representatives on behalf of De Facto Attorneys General or Special Forces of Liberty to sponsor the Marriage and Constitution Restoration Act and the related resolution by Rep. Garber, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.*

Count 39—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about February 9, 2021, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted a representative on behalf of De Facto Attorneys General or Special Forces of Liberty to sponsor a bill to stop social media censorship that 28 other states are running*, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 72—Unlawful Lobbying



Count 73—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about December 10, 2021, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted a representative on behalf of De Facto Attorneys General to sponsor a bi-partisan measure entitled "Save Our Children Act (SOCA) in the form of a bill*, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.

Count 74—Unlawful Lobbying

On or about January 2, 2022, John Gunter, Jr., a lobbyist, did then lobby without being registered or lobby when a current report under K.S.A. 46-268 and 46-269 has not been filed and is past due, *to-wit: contacted a representative on behalf of De Facto Attorneys General to sponsor a bi-partisan measure entitled "Fight Exploitation Funding Act (FEFA) in the form of a bill*, in violation of K.S.A. 46-274, a class B misdemeanor, and, in addition to any other penalty prescribed under K.S.A. 46-215 through 46-286, and amendments thereto, the commission may assess a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the first violation, not to exceed \$10,000 for the second violation, and not to exceed \$15,000 for the third violation and for each subsequent violation, pursuant to K.S.A. 46-288.
