












## Would it Help the Kansas Economy to Lower Taxes?








### Workforce Size Over Next Year








### Satisfaction with Workforce?








# Why Not Rate Workforce Higher? (Open Ended)








### Greatest Concern with Kansas Workforce?
















### Kansas Has Best Business Climate in America?
