Dear Mr. Herrmann:

On August 14, 2024, we received the transcript of proceedings for the above-referenced Bonds for review and approval. In your cover letter, you advised that Greeley County did not have a website. As a result, no Notice of Bond Election whatsoever was posted online as required by K.S.A. 10-120. Despite this, you argued that notwithstanding this "unique circumstance," the result of the special election was still valid. On August 16, 2024, you provided additional arguments and authorities in support of your position.

We have reviewed the transcript of proceedings for sufficiency. Following review, we decline to approve the request of the district to allow the use of proceeds from the Bonds.
