PARDON

Richard McMichael

WHEREAS, Richard McMichael was convicted on or about April 13, 2018, in the 7th Judicial District, Douglas County, Kansas of the crimes of distribution of alprazolam, in violation of K.S.A. 65-4111; 21-5705(a)(2)(d)(4)(B), possession of drug paraphernalia, in violation of K.S.A. 21-5709(b)(1), and aggravated battery, in violation of K.S.A. 21-5413(b)(1)(B), and was sentenced to 61 months in prison, with 36 months of post-release supervision (Case No. 2017 CR 1129); and

WHEREAS, Richard McMichael was discharged from prison on March 13, 2024;

WHEREAS, Richard McMichael, by his application and evidence submitted in support thereof, including his exemplary conduct while incarcerated, educational and occupational success, and his return to life as a law-abiding citizen, has paid his debt to society and shown that he is deserving of executive discretion to grant a full and unconditional pardon.


NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Kansas by Article 1, Section 7 of the Kansas Constitution and K.S.A. 22-3701 and 22-3702, I hereby pardon Richard McMichael as to the aforesaid convictions for the crimes listed above.
