PARDON

Anthony Mitchell

WHEREAS, Anthony Mitchell was convicted on or about November 14, 2005, in the 29th Judicial District, Wyandotte County District Court, Kansas, of the crime of possession of cocaine, in violation of K.S.A. 65-4160(A), and was sentenced to 12 months of probation (Case No. 05 CR 1498); and

WHEREAS, Anthony Mitchell has satisfactorily completed his sentence, and an order of expungement was issued by the Wyandotte County District Court on or about July 27, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Anthony Mitchell, by his application and evidence submitted in support thereof, including his completion of his sentence, service to his community, and through good conduct in the intervening 19 years since his last conviction, has paid his debt to society and shown that he is deserving of executive discretion to grant a full and unconditional pardon.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Kansas by Article 1, Section 7 of the Kansas Constitution and K.S.A. 22-3701 and 22-3702, I hereby pardon Anthony Mitchell as to the aforesaid convictions for the crimes listed above.
